




Thank You Note from Land of Peace to Father Brian ...





From October 20th to 24th, sixty panels from the International Exhibition of the Eucharistic Miracles of the World will be on display at Divine Redeemer Parish. The exhibition was designed and created by Saint Carlo Acutis, a young man who used his gifts as a computer whiz to create a website cataloging every Eucharistic Miracle recorded in history. In 2006, he passed away at the age of 15 due to a rare type of leukemia. He was beatified only 14 years later in 2020 and canonized on September 7, 2025. By viewing this collection, you can experience the history of these documented miracles, as well as learn about the faithful life of Saint Carlo and his journey to Sainthood.


