April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month!

Blue Sunday: Observed on Sunday, April 26, "Blue Sunday" is a National Day of Prayer for victims of abuse. On this day, please pray the Holy Rosary or the Divine Mercy Chaplet and spend some time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.

Parish and School Volunteers: If you have completed the requirements of the Diocese of Pittsburgh's Safe Environment policy, please know that you will receive requests from our Safe Environment Coordinator, Susan Ponticello, when your clearances are about to expire. The diocese requires updated clearances every five years. The Protecting God's Children recertification class needs to be completed three years after the initial completion. You will receive an email from Virtus when the Protecting God's Children Class needs to be completed again. When you receive these requests, please be sure to complete the required items within two months to assure that we remain in full compliance with the Safe Environment Policy.

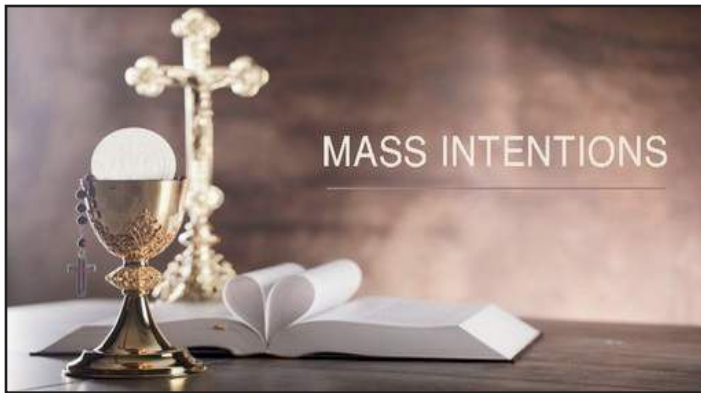
