

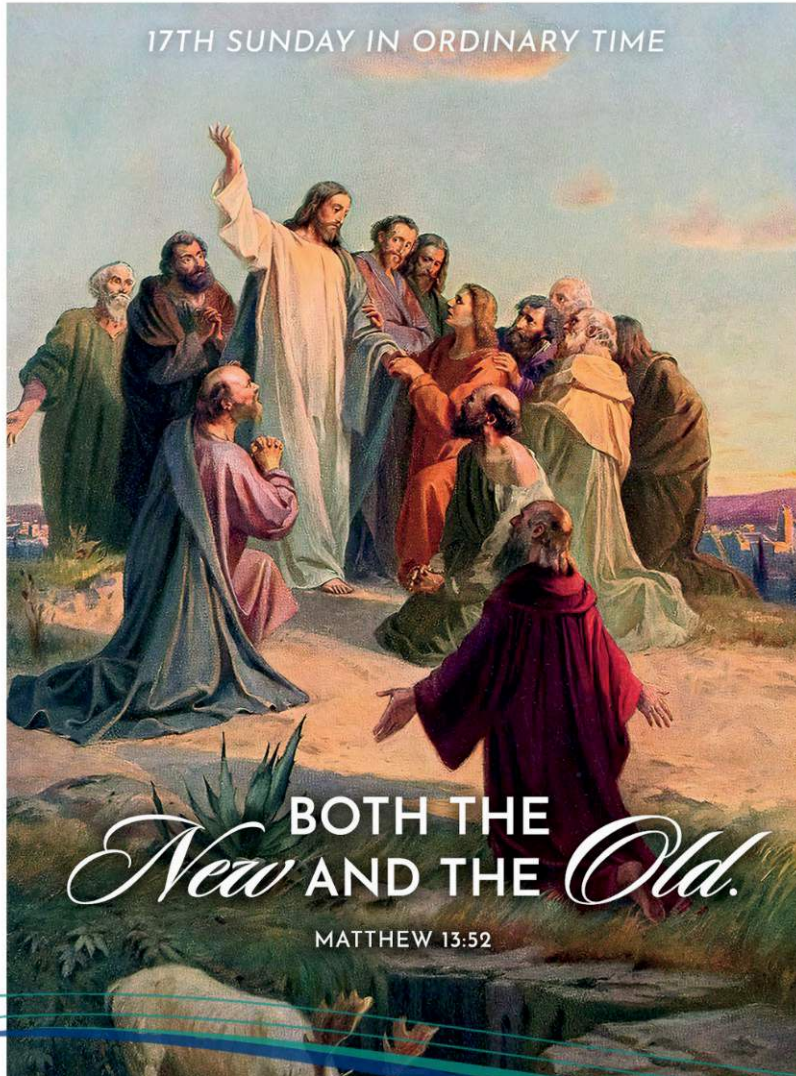

Eighth Centenary of the Transitus of Saint Francis

My mind goes back exactly twenty years ago to when I had the privilege of staying for a month in the medieval Umbrian town of Assisi, made famous by the life and times of God's little, poor one, Saint Francis, called "Il Poverello." Several of us seminarians were there to learn Italian in anticipation of our upcoming theology studies that fall.

Daily, I would attend Holy Mass in the morning at one of the many churches located throughout the old town. Often, I would go to the monastery founded by Santa Clare. Other times, to the church built adjacent to the house where Saint Francis grew up; Those quiet, cobblestone streets were a joy to walk through in the early hours, before the shops opened and the visitors arrived to explore the ancient town. The medieval life of the Saint is still reflected in so much of the architecture and culture of Assisi

Fast-forward to 2026, a special Jubilee has been announced: 800 years since the death of Saint Francis. With it, we reflect anew on how Il Poverello and his companions walked those Assisi streets, teaching God's love in a radical way: By living in solidarity with the most impoverished of the community. By this witness, God renewed His Church.

In its decree, the Church grants a plenary indulgence for those who, "...with a heart detached from sin, participate in the Year of Saint Francis by visiting, in the form of a pilgrimage, any Franciscan conventual church...and there devoutly follow the Jubilee rites or spend at least a reasonable period of time in pious meditation and raise prayers to God so that, following the example of Saint Francis, feelings of Christian charity towards their neighbours and authentic vows of harmony and peace among peoples may spring forth in their hearts."

Although it is not Assisi, the Parish will make a summer day-pilgrimage to Loretto, PA, home of the Franciscan Friars, Third Order Regular (T.O.R.'s). **Save the date for Wednesday, August 5th**, and see the flyer for information concerning our special trip to the designated Jubilee sites in Cambria County dedicated to Il Poverello!

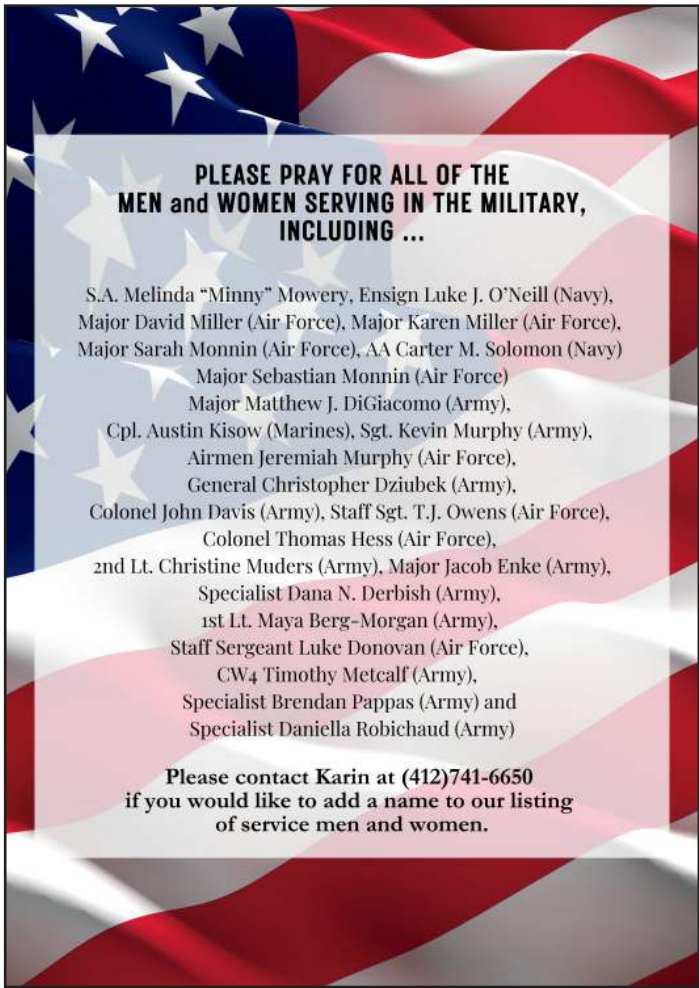

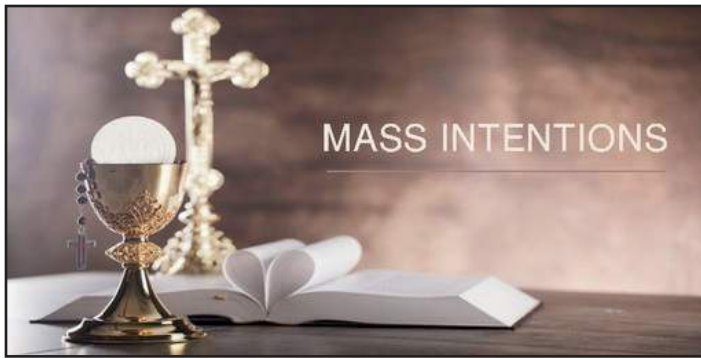
