believe an abstract idea (like the Force in Star Wars) or do you know the Holy Spirit (of God)?

Who is the Holy Spirit (not what)? The 3rd Divine Person of the Trinity. Sent by the Father and the Son at Pentecost and at our baptism and confirmation. The One who dwells within those who believe in Jesus and Who brings life and an abundant growth to the Spiritual Gifts & Fruits as well as to the natural virtues. The Holy Spirit gives gifts to each person as God determines is best for them and the Church and will lead us into holiness through these gifts. This holiness is a life like Jesus, for our salvation as well as for others. Here is a prayer to the Holy Spirit that I pray frequently. There is another prayer on the backside specifically asking for the Holy Spirit's guidance.

This prayer struck me in that the Holy Spirit is "soul of my soul" and so is my life. Without my soul, I am dead; without the Holy Spirit, my soul is dead, eternally. The Holy Spirit (God) is all to me and so I desire to do anything He asks; yet I often need God to command me - to make it clear and give me the courage to act. I want to submit to the will of the Holy Spirit because I Only show me what is Your will.

O Holy Spirit, soul of my soul, I adore You. Enlighten, guide, strengthen, and console me. Tell me what I ought to do and command me to do it. I promise to be submissive in everything that You ask of me, and to accept all that You permit to happen to me.

believe that God is all Good, all Knowing, all Loving, all Powerful, etc. and so everything He asks of me and allows to happen is for Good! Whether my own or for others. I ask again to know that I am doing what is Good and Right so that I may battle all opposition and persevere to the end. Is that your desire? To be led, taught, strengthened and consoled by the One who cares most for you? Do you want to do the Good and to trust in God so as to know that everything has a good purpose, a good end? Don't you want to know God's will so that you can do it confidently and courageously? I hope and pray that this is the desire of your heart. Even if we have only a small seed of desire, we can pray, "Lord I believe, help my unbelief."

God desires that all be saved and so Jesus did not come to condemn but to save. The Holy Spirit remains in me as the first fruits of the promise of God's love unless I push him out by my sin and rebellion - refusing to follow his guidance in God's commands.

So ask yourself these questions: Do I experience the power of the Holy Spirit in my life? Do I see Him active in the world? How am I living in Faith, Hope, and Charity? Am I growing in holiness, virtue, and the gifts and fruits of the Spirit? And pray the prayer printed above twice - once with your mind, and a second time with your heart.
