

THERE WILL ARISE THE SUN OF JUSTICE WITH ITS HEALING RAYS.

The imagery in today's Gospel is more than a bit frightening. Yet God has planted in the Bible reminders that despite how dark life on Earth can get, God is present and powerful. God is in our midst, *Do not be afraid.*

Often on the prairie, the late afternoon sun breaks through the clouds in such a way as to shed rays of light upon the Earth. The Irish have an expression for this, *cosa na gréine*, which means *the legs of the sun*—it's God walking over our wounded World.

Through poverty and illness, through fields full of landmines or poisonous landfills, through wildfires, crumbling coastlines or cities choking on pollution, the Healing Rays of Heaven (God's legs) walk among us.

Even in persecution or depression, God's presence is near. In betrayal and conflicts, God is near. He never abandons his people. When the Church appears weak, de-

SYNOD OF THE DIOCESE OF FARGO. SYNOD – *syn-* (together) + *-od* (way). We continue with Pope Francis’ groundbreaking catechesis on the worldwide Synod. His words prepare us for embracing our own Synod in the Diocese of Fargo. Reflecting on Jesus’ meeting with a rich young man, Francis pulls out 3 lessons using 3 key words: *Encounter, listen and discern.* The first was ‘encounter’.

“The second verb is *listen.* True encounter arises only from listening. Jesus listened to that man’s question and to the concerns that lay behind it. He did not offer a prepackaged solution or pretend to respond politely as a way of dismissing him and continuing on his way. Jesus simply listens, for whatever amount of time it takes; he is not rushed. Most importantly, he is not afraid *to listen to him with his heart* and not just with his ears. Indeed, he does more than simply answer the rich man’s question; he lets him tell his story, to speak freely about himself. Christ reminds him of the commandments, and the man starts to talk about his youth, to share his religious journey and his efforts to seek God. This happens whenever we listen with the heart: people feel that they are being heard, not judged; they feel free to recount their own experiences and their spiritual journey.

“Let us ask ourselves frankly during this synodal process: Are we good at listening?”

In the recent *New Earth*, Bishop Folda listed listening sessions where we’ll encounter one another as a Church looking to the future. In the next few wks, however, the Diocese is asking each of us to take a survey.

Parish Self-Reflection

As part of our Fargo Diocesan Synod we are doing a parish self-reflection survey. The goal of this survey is three-fold. To Gauge where the faith of the Church is at in the Diocese of Fargo. To Help the faithful reflect upon where they are at and where they could be. To Begin the discussion about what the next steps are to help get us where the Holy Spirit wants us to be.
