

If you do, what does this Helping Hand feel like?



**SYNOD AND THE YOUTH.** Young Catholics who went to World Youth Day in Lisbon, Portugal, knew about the upcoming Synod on Synodality. They shared many of the concerns expressed during its preparatory phases and wanted to share their prayers and hopes with the synod members who will meet at the Vatican in October.



There at WYD, Francis implored the young people. "Indeed, never forget who you really are," he said, "the faithful holy People of God walking in the joy of the Gospel!" These words wonderfully illustrate the Synod logo.

These young people see themselves as walking with the Church. Their presence opens the Church to the invigorating breath of the next generation. They are God's people inheriting realities and desires different from what we're used

to.

On the way home from Portugal, a reporter reminded Francis that during the trip, he said the Church was open to "everyone, everyone, everyone" and asked if it was not incoherent that some, such as women and gay people, did not have the same rights and could not receive some sacraments.

"The Church is open to everyone but there are laws that regulate life inside the Church. According to the legislation, they cannot partake in (some) Sacraments. This does not mean that it is closed. Each person encounters God in their own way inside the Church.... Ministers in the Church had to accompany all people, including those not conforming to the rules, with the patience and love of a mother."
