A CHANGE OF MIND"

Did Jesus ever get nervous? Ever change his mind? Did his emotions influence his decisions, his words?

Some think Jesus knew all along he was going to cure the woman's daughter. He delayed only to test her faith. Possibly.

Can we look at it another way?

"[T]he Son of God... worked with human hands, he thought with a human mind, acted by human choice and loved with a

human heart...—one like us in all things except sin" (Vatican II, Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World, par. 22). It's not a sin to change one's mind.

The Church further teaches, "This human soul that the Son of God assumed is endowed with a true human knowledge. As such, this knowledge could not in itself be unlimited: it was exercised in the historical conditions of his existence in space and time. This is why the Son of God...

In today's Gospel, the human situation for Jesus is this: the authorities were turning against him; his popularity became stifling. Aware that his time was limited, Jesus ventured into foreign territory, seeking to keep a low profile as he taught his disciples some essentials. He meets a woman who calls him out. She's not on his agenda. He gives an initial response, somewhat harsh and put-offish. She persists. Amazed at what he hears, he follows through with her re-

quest, accepting the risk that he's exposed his identity.

Do you ever aim to do one thing, but end up doing something else? If so, you have a friend in Jesus. He knows what it's like to be human. It's not a sin to adapt to circumstances. It's not a sin to have to struggle to figure out the right words to use. Jesus knew a normal range of human experiences while remaining united in love with his Eternal Father.

Thanks to the Canaanite woman's persistence, we have a great Gospel that gives us permission to have a change of mind.

Jesus belongs to everybody—and even he needed a while to let that sink in. He had a gut-check and began to understand better how the Father's House is **OPEN TO ALL**. Does your idea of who Jesus is need to change?






A HARVEST PRAYER
