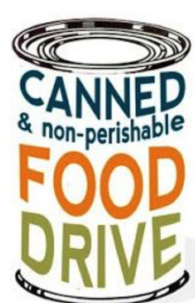


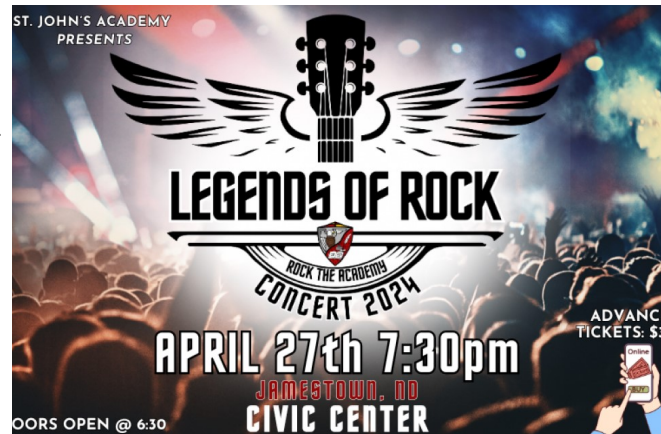

"I am well aware that speaking of a 'Synod on Synodality' may seem like something excessively technical and of little interest to the general public, but what has happened over the past year, which will continue with the second stage of Synod in Oct, 2024, is something truly important for the Church," Pope Francis said. Elsewhere he emphasized that to reform the Church is to put God first and to love and serve others. "This is the Church we are called to 'dream': a Church that is the servant of all, the servant of the least of our brothers and sisters; a Church that never demands evidence of 'good behavior,' but welcomes, serves, loves, forgives; a Church with open doors that is a haven of mercy. We may have plenty of good ideas on how to reform the Church, but let's remember: to adore God and to love our brothers and sisters with his love, that is the great and perennial reform"
