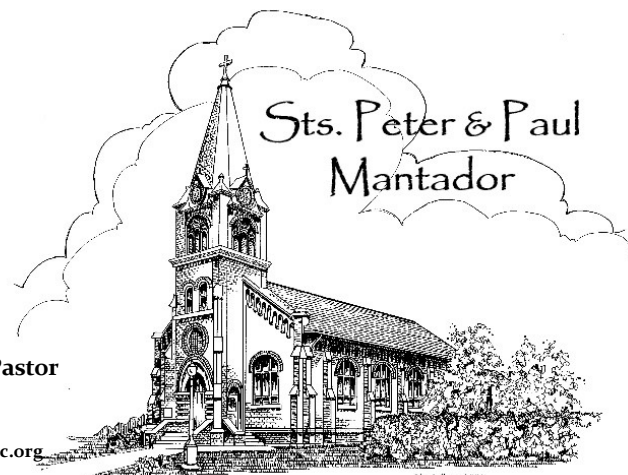

This Lent, each wk, we will be viewing episodes from *The Chosen*, Season Two, which focuses on the beginning of Jesus's public ministry and what happens as word of His ministry begins to spread. See Jesus through the eyes of those who met Him. **THE PLAN: TUE-MANTADOR; WED-MOORETON:** Exposition of Bl Sacrament 5:30 pm with Stations of the Cross;



Mass at 6pm; Simple, single dish meal, 6:30pm—see sign-up sheets to host a meal. While we eat, we'll watch *The Chosen*. For those who wish to stick around (BYOB), there'll be a discussion afterwards.

Wk1: Episode 1 *Thunder*. Tension builds among the disciples as they wrestle with the increasing fame of Jesus, who rebukes Big James and John, after a near-violent encounter, for their prejudice, then gives the brothers a nickname.

Wk 2: Episode 2 *I Saw You*. A mysterious visitor seeks to meet Jesus, but the disciples are hesitant. Tension builds between Simon and Matthew. Jesus' fame continues to grow. **AND Episode 3 *Matthew 4:24*.** A long, exhausting day turns into night as the disciples help Jesus deal with a large crowd hoping to be healed. Around the campfire, the group tries to get to know each other better, but tensions erupt.

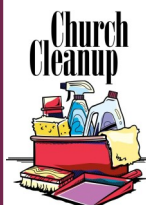
