

FULFILLMENT. Mr Pletzer, my highschool physics teacher, blew me away when he described that the Earth has eight movements. Some are hard to wrap your mind around. Here's a few: 1. Point is, we're moving in many directions simultaneously; some we notice, some we don't. It's a way of saying there are a lot of perspectives at work to stand your ground in the Real World.

Change is hard. Changing perspectives can be stressful. A British energy company surveyed 2,000 people, and found 6 out of 10 people think moving is the most stressful life event. Divorce/break up was 2nd, death of a loved one was 3rd.

ior." His response is baffling, "Destroy this Temple and in the 3 days I will raise it up." He is


in the 3 days I will raise it up." He is referring to the Paschal Mystery. Big yet unseen changes are coming.

surface of those changes of routine that characterize our Lenten exercises? Are you aware of Jesus rearranging any furniture in your house?


