

THURSDAY, April 17, 2025 – HOLY THURSDAY School Stations of the Cross 9:00 a.m.

Parish Potluck Dinner & Fellowship 5:30 p.m.

Mass of the Lord's Supper - 7:00 p.m. Confessions & Adoration in the Life House

8:30 p.m. until Midnight

We will have the Parish Potluck Dinner from 5:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. in the School Cafeteria. Please consider bringing your tastiest meat dish and 1 side for your family.

(After 6:00 p.m., we ask that no one consume any food or drink including tea or coffee. This will allow for the required 1-Hour Fast prior the worthy reception of the Eucharist at the Mass of the Lord's Supper.)

From 6:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., we will have fellowship and the optional participation in the washing of feet. In the past, Bishops used to invite individuals to a communal meal followed by a few persons having their feet washed. In ACTS and other retreats/ events, there are opportunities to wash or have one's feet washed. I invite members of families to partake in this opportunity.

We will then proceed to the Mass of the Lord's Supper followed by adoration in the Life House. This year, we will have a change in the Eucharistic Procession at the conclusion of the Mass of the Lord's Supper. The procession will begin by going down the aisles of the church. Instead of ending at the St. Joseph's side of the Church, the Eucharistic Procession will exit through the Mother Mary's side door, pass through the school's glass doors, and continue down the sidewalk to the Life House. All are welcome to process into the Life House where we will have the chapel of repose.

Those wishing to spend time in prayer until Midnight, are encouraged to park by the Life House gate.

(At the end of the procession, the choir will remain in the church and sing the final 2 verses of the Tantum Ergo. If you do not process to the Life House, please depart in silence and prayer.)

- Make the sign of the cross and say: Bless me Father, for I have sinned.
 Next say: My last confession was _______.
- 3. Then say your sins: These are my sins _____, ____, and _____
- 4. Next say: I am sorry for these and all of the sins of my life.
- 5. Then listen to what the priest tells you. Father will give you a penance to do.
- 6. Father will ask you to pray the Act of Contrition (say it loudly)

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of hell, but most of all, because they offend You, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Your grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

- 7. Then the priest gives you Absolution, the forgiveness of your sins.

 Listen silently and make the sign of the cross when Father says: *I absolve you from your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.*Then answer: Amen.
- 8. Father may say: Give thanks to the Lord for He is good. You say: His mercy endures forever.


