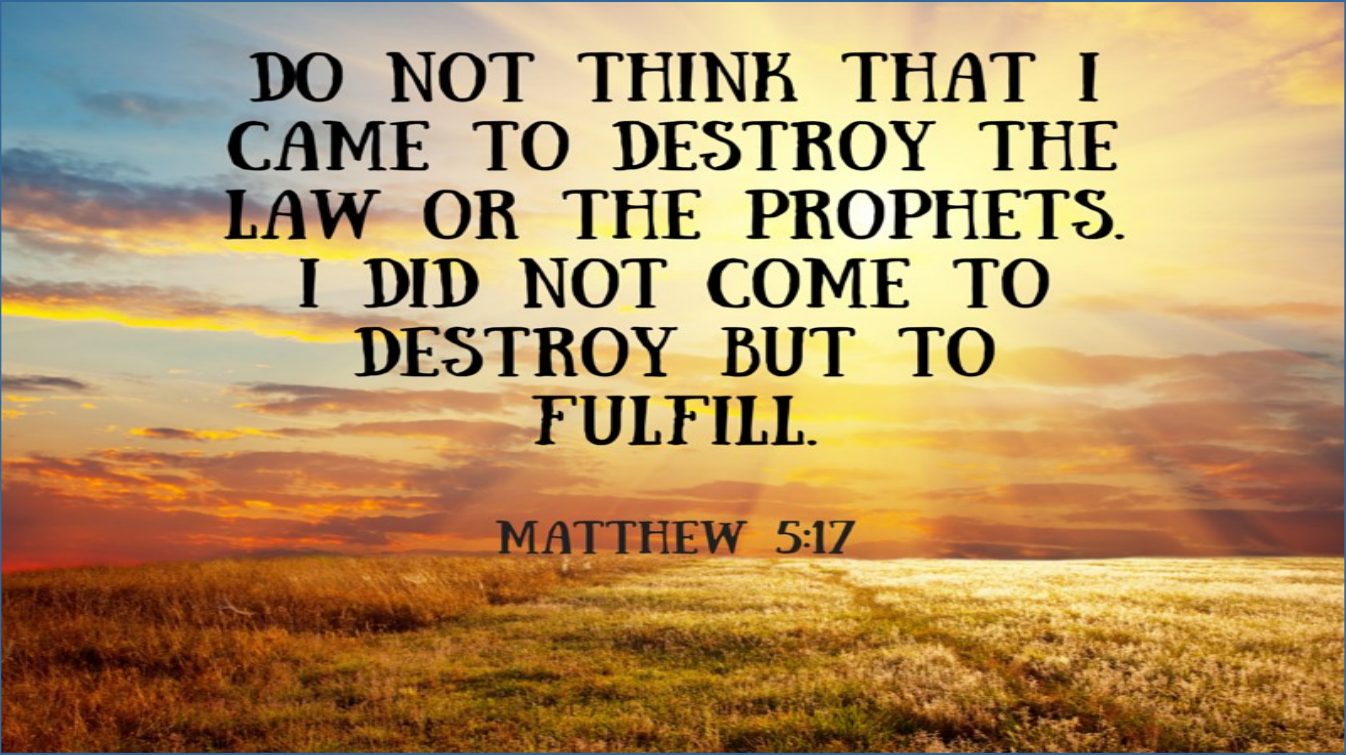

Sacrament of Holy Matrimony

Must notify the pastor six months in advance to begin marriage preparation and Pre-Cana. PLEASE NOTE: Father Dan will only be celebrating weddings at St. Eulalia, St. Gabriel, St. Bibiana, St. Augustine or Sacred Heart Churches. For future reference, those requesting his presence for weddings outside of these churches, couples will be required to pay for a visiting priest for weekend coverage (\$450).

Sacrament of Holy Orders

Sacrament of Baptism

Appointments can be made to have children baptized on Sundays either during or after the celebration of Holy Mass.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Students and adults who are prepared through religious education or R.C.I.A. are eligible for Confirmation.

Requirements for Baptism & Confirmation Sponsors

For Baptism: Both sponsors MUST be baptized, only one sponsor needs to be a practicing catholic; There is a reasonable hope that the child will be raised in the PRACTICE of the faith, by either the parents example, or by someone else bringing the children to the sacraments regularly.

Confirmation: The sponsor must be baptized and confirmed; The sponsor must be a registered parishioner and attend mass regularly; If you have taken up residency elsewhere for six months or more, you must apply at a church there. This does not apply to college students.

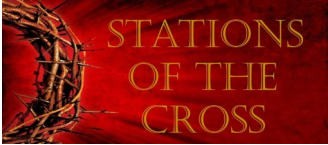

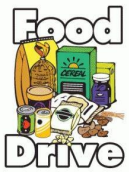

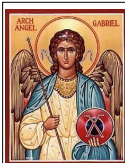
Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments—Bystanders can help. Bystanders can play a big role in stopping bullying. When people do nothing, it sends a message that it's no big deal to bully. If people say something, it sends a social message that bullying is not OK. If you see someone being bullied, you can help by doing these things: *Speak up to help:* If it feels safe and natural to speak up, say, "come on, let's get out of here" to the person being bullied. It is okay to let the bully know people are watching and will get involved. *Report it:* Let a trusted adult know what you witnessed. This isn't tattling, it is standing up for what's right. *Offer support:* Check in with the person who was being bullied. Ask how they are doing. Remind them that the bullying is not their fault. 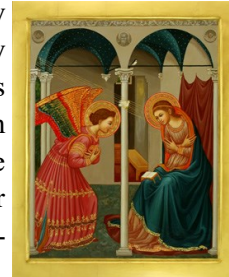
