Dear Parishioners,

Bishop Edward Malesic is encouraging everyone to wear a mask to church (whether vaccinated or non vaccinated). This is a recommendation and not a requirement. I would ask everyone (Vaccinated and non vaccinated) to honor this request beginning the weekend of September 11th and 12th. The Bishop is also recommending that everyone consider being vaccinated. He was vaccinated. I was vaccinated and sincerely hope everyone will consult with their health care provider and if appropriate, get vaccinated.

We do sanitize the commonly touched areas of our church. We will continue to have hand sanitizer and masks at our exits. We empty and clean the holy water fonts after each weekend.

Finally some of our parishioners have asked me to address the concern of loud talking in the church before Mass. If you wish to talk, please talk quietly so you do not distract others who are trying to pray or meditate in our church.

This weekend we remember the victims of 9/11, their families, and our country. Praying the 5 decade rosary everyday would be a good way to bring in peace in our individual lives, our families, and our world. This was the request of Our Lady of Fatima. We will have an 11:15 a.m. Marian Prayer service on Sunday, September 12th in our church. The Holy Eucharist will be solemnly exposed in the monstrance on the altar of sacrifice. The rosary will be prayed. There will be a short reflection followed by Benediction and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Please join us in prayer.

Thank you for your kind consideration of the above requests.

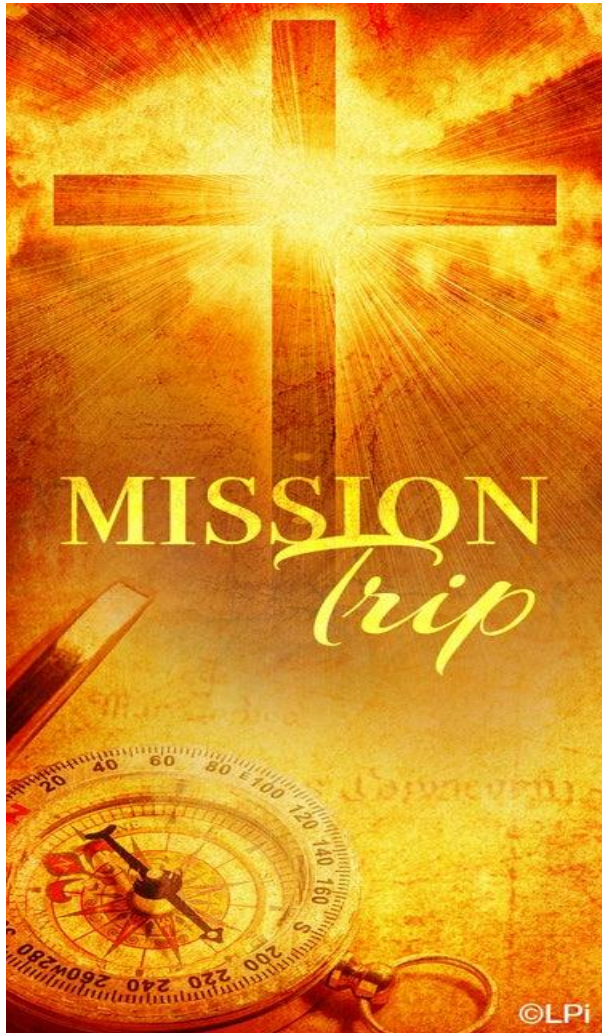

Virtual Missionary Weekend of September 11th and 12th

Focus of Pallottine Missionaries.



Our Missionary Focus for 2021 is to help and assist the Irish Pallottine Missionary Works located in East Africa. Currently our Missionary focus has three aspects to it; to feed, to educate and to provide care for the most vulnerable in society.

Farming in East Africa is dependent on water and labor. Labor is not the problem, but a shortage of water can be. A two, three or four year drought leads to localized famine and the death of crops, animals and humans. By providing community water supplies through drilling water wells we are able to sustain a local village of over 200 families through drought periods.

In addition, we also assist local communities by providing Greenhouse facilities to allow food to be grown in a controlled environment throughout the year. A \$25,000 well will provide water to a community for over 10 years, and with small maintenance costs of \$100 per year many additional years.

The Siuyu Rehabilitation Center was established by Fr Tommy Ryan, who felt there was a great need for a facility to take care of children with disabilities. The center has 4 dormitories and many volunteers to assist in keeping the center functioning.

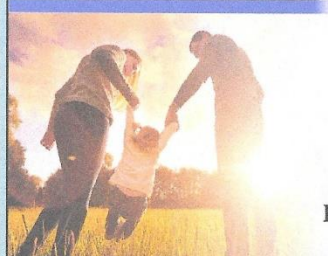

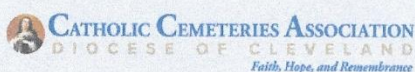
