Ways to Increase Your Devotion to the Eucharist

The Pope encourages us "to cultivate in our hearts a constant desire for the Sacrament of the Eucharist." The practice of "spiritual communion," in which you ask the Lord to enter your heart, is an opportunity for union with God at times when you cannot receive the sacrament. It is not a substitute, however.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is "a priceless treasure" and a "wellspring of grace. "It prolongs and increases the fruits of our communion and provides an opportunity to express our gratitude and love.

Observation of the one hour fast before receiving communion is a preparation for reception of the sacrament. Before Mass, contemplate with awe and wonder the mystery that will unfold in the Eucharist.

Participate in the Mass by listening carefully to the words during the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist, by responding enthusiastically, and by singing with the congregation.

Always demonstrate the utmost respect and reverence when receiving the Eucharist. Take time after receiving communion for a few moments of private prayer and thanksgiving.

Carry the Eucharist in your heart when you leave the church as an instrument of Christ's love. Share with others the ways in which the Eucharist touches your life.

"Adoration means entering the depths of our hearts in communion with the Lord, who makes Himself bodily present in the Eucharist. In the monstrance, He always entrusts Himself to us and asks us to be united with His Presence, with His Risen Body. ~ Benedict XVI

This Sunday, June 7th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. We will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 4PM-6PM in our parish church. At 6PM, we will have sung evening prayer (Vespers), which will conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.


