



With this being the fifth week of Lent, it means that Holy Week is approaching. Perhaps this week we can all remind ourselves to take the time, look at the schedule, and then make a firm decision to join the parish community in the celebration of the events that changed the world as we know it today. The Sacred Triduum is the shortest and most important season of the Liturgical Calendar. Holy Thursday marks the event of the Last Supper where our Lord gave the church his very self in the Eucharist. It was also the night when the beginning of the priesthood was revealed when he washed the feet of the apostles to indicated that we must serve rather than be served. To honor that moment, the Church placed the Mandatum, or the mandate, within the Holy Thursday liturgy. Don't forget to mark your calendar for April 27th-29th as we celebrate our parish at the "Gala of Gratitude" and the Parish Ministry Fair! More information is at the doors of the church and Family Center. I am looking forward to that weekend as we come to celebrate in gratitude what God has done for us and how we may respond, in gratitude, what we can do for God, through his Son, with the power of the Holy Spirit!
