As I write this, it's cold and rainy outside and many folks are wondering if summer will ever come! While New Englanders are a hardy bunch, we do appreciate good weather when it arrives. Once again, it is the perspective of living with gratitude rather than the attitude of demanding self-satisfaction for every moment of our lives. Jesus tells us in today's gospel that, "... whoever does the will of God is my brother, sister and mother." 
We recently sold the condominium we owned on Penacook Dr. for 155,500. After expenses, the parish received 150,000. The money was applied to the mortgage of the rectory. This leaves a balance of 60,973.89. The Finance Committee has worked diligently to pay off the mortgage ASAP as well as continuing to monitor our financial situation. This includes striving to keep a balanced budget, keeping pace with our expenses, and to communicate to the parish all pertinent information which helps us all to make an informed contribution. As we enter the final quarter of our fiscal year which ends on August 31, the weekly collection is not keeping pace with our expenses. Our Lady of the Lake Parish has stewardship in its spiritual DNA! In the weeks ahead, the Finance Committee and I will be formulating a plan to address this shortfall as well as begin to formulate a budget for the 2018-19 Fiscal Year. Please keep the parish in your prayers as we face the challenges ahead. Let us do the will of God together!



## **SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING CODE OF CONDUCT AND CORI REMINDERS FOR CATECHISTS AND ALL VOLUNTEERS!**

As you start to plan your volunteer time for the bazaar and teaching ministry in the fall, please remember that you must fill out an updated CORI form, with a photo of the front of your license each year. That form must be turned in to the office so that we can mail it in to the Office for Healing and Prevention. Code of Conduct is a small leaflet that you read and sign the accompanying code of conduct form saying that you have read the material. The Code of Conduct is signed only once and is kept on file here at OLL. Forms are available on the table on the landing outside the Religious Ed offices.

Every person who volunteers in the parish must receive one time Safe Environment Training which is a 2 hour training program that better enables you to identify signs of abuse and helps you to learn proper methods of responding to victims of abuse.
