

Dear Friends.

In the first reading today, Sirach states, "The fruit of the tree shows the care it has had; so too does one's speech disclose the bent one's mind." (27:6) Have you had the experience of speaking too quickly and wishing you could take all those words back? It isn't always about saying something untoward or unkind. Sometimes we simply misspeak or misquote someone else's words, or offer an opinion that could be more informed about the topic at hand. Or, put more simply, think before you speak, as our parents clearly taught us!

These days, evidence of the lack of thought before speaking abound in the Church, in politics, in entertainment as it is shown and reported by the media. Oftentimes rhetoric is taken as fact and opinions become absolute in the face of contradictory evidence. The message of mercy, kindness, compassion, are often reported as "human interest" stories rather than being taken as a counterpoint to the other more "newsworthy" stories.

This last Sunday before Lent begins offers us all the opportunity to go more deeply into ourselves to find well God already knows us and loves us nonetheless. It is a time to prepare for that Lenten encounter of our need for God's mercy which is always there in abundance! Take advantage of that mercy which is waiting for you every moment of the day. For in that mercy alone will we find how to love God in return for all God has done for us! Peace, Fr. Michael


