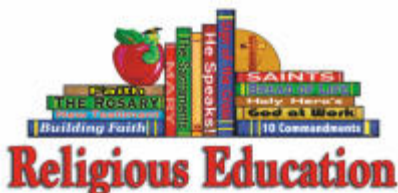


Please join us the weekend of February 13/14 to hear Fr. Richard Lewandowski speak at all Masses about a ministry providing direct relief to the poor throughout

This effort began in 1990 with youth from one church in Georgia and now extends to over 14,500 churches in the US and Canada. Last year over 10 million dollars was distributed to feed the poor.

Last year, \$1,833. was raised and distributed to the Brown Bag Ministry, Our Lady of the Lake's effort to extend the reach of our Food Pantry. This puts our Twenty-year total of donations at over \$28,833., every penny of which has been given to local food shelters. We will be collecting donations for our food pantry again this year.
