You might want to file this under, "Who Knew?!" The granite base for the statue of the Resurrected Christ, in memory of Fr. Dennis, is still in process and might not be here for a few more weeks. A couple of months ago I read an article in the paper that said monument companies in the Granite State are running three shifts, seven days a week, to keep up with the demand for grave markers, monuments, and pedestals. This is a direct result of the thousands of deaths caused by the COVID19 virus and the many people who are "putting their affairs in order." Therefore, we will postpone the dedication of the statue until the Spring.


