

It has been said that anytime a major character in the Scriptures remains nameless, that person acts as the universal person standing in for each of us. Remember the "beloved disciple, the one whom Jesus loved?" Many commentators have delved deeply into finding out exactly who this person was but they come up empty handed, without the surety they were looking for. Once again, this beloved disciple can be considered the "stand-in" for each of us.

Knowing someone by their na+++me gives us their identity. How often have your wracked your brain, unable to think of a persons name even though we claim to know them? It's painful, isn't it? I suspect it might have happened already today! In baptism, we are given our name and our indelible mark as a child of God. For the rest of our lives we are called by name each day to live out our

baptismal promises.

This weekend begins the Rite of Scrutiny for our RCIA candidates who will be baptized, confirmed, and receive the eucharist at the Easter Vigil. The Scrutinies, as they are more commonly referred to, is a public and prayerful rite that asks God for deliverance from anything that is a barrier between the God and themselves. It can be a very intense experience for the community as well! We are asked. especially during this season of purification and enlightenment, to go deeper to the well of grace as did the Samaritan woman, and encounter the Lord and drink of the water of life. Please pray for our RCIA candidates, their sponsors and the Team as the Lenten journey continues.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS!

Our diocesan policy requires that all those whose work brings them in contact with children receive Safe Environment Training. This applies to all Catechists, volunteers, Aides, Eucharistic Ministers, Greeters, and Lectors. For those who have not already attended a session, the training is available online. To register for the Online Course, email dbronchuk@ourladylake.org. You will be contacted by Cathaleen Peloquin from the Office of Healing and Prevention who will send you the link for the online training. Once you have completed the training you must send the certificate to Debbie Bronchuk. If you have any questions please contact Debbie at the Religious Ed. Office, or dbronchuk@ourladylake.org. Our Parish requires that you fill out a CORI form every three years (with attached copy of your driver's license) and the new Code of Ministerial Conduct. These forms can be found on the table outside the Religious Ed Office in the Parish Family Center.
