Father's Reflection

REST YOUR RESTLESS HEARTS

In my seminary formation, spiritual reading was a requirement daily. The life journies of Saints are indeed inspiring. I remember vividly St. Augustine in his youthful years searching for life's meaning. In his beautiful and inspiring book entitled "Confession," which recounts his life up to his conversion to the Catholic faith, he opened with this immortalized statement: "You have made us for you, Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in you."

Gerald G. May, a contemporary clinical psychiatrist said: "After twenty years of listening to the yearnings of people's hearts, I am convinced that all human beings have an inborn desire for God. Whether we are consciously religious or not, this desire is our deepest longing... Regardless of how we describe it, it is a longing for love. It is a hunger to love, to be loved, and to move closer to the source of love."

If we look at today's gospel, we find a little man whose heart was restless, like all human hearts. He had money and power, but apparently no satisfaction from them. It says: "He was seeking to see Jesus." The little man was seeking. Perhaps, he was one of those men who lead lives of quiet desperation. At any rate, he was so desperate to see Jesus that it led him "up a tree." In other words, he placed himself at a disadvantage and in an embarrassing situation.

Perhaps that was the only thing needed for Jesus to find him. For Jesus had been seeking Zacchaeus since the beginning of creation. Jesus knew that only He, as the God who had made Zacchaeus, could give rest to the little man's restless heart. God alone satisfies the deepest longing in each one's heart. God alone suffices!

We are all in search of God, whether we admit it or not, whether we are aware of it or not. Unfortunately, we hold on to too many things, and these prevent us from enjoying God as fully as it is possible in this life.

Restless? Rest in God!




