REFLECTION

The Lord Is Our Provider

Eternal life is our goal and vocation. The total submission to God and the proper use of His providence will help us understand that life is more than gaining material things, but happiness in God alone. The rich man in today's gospel raises a question concerning eternal life. Jesus told him to sell everything or give it to the poor and follow Him. The reaction of the rich man lead Him to sadness because His heart is attached to his earthly wealth.

Wealth is a blessing and providence from God. However, we must not be deceived that wealth will give us permanent happiness. As Christians, we must acknowledge that we have a providential gift from God. We need to use these resources to glorify Him rather than glorifying ourselves. The rich man in the Gospel was faithful to the Law of Moses but his heart is not fully attached to God. His wealth pulls him down to reach eternal life. Let us imitate Abraham in the Old Testament, he is wealthy and his heart belongs to God. The Patriarch Abraham said, “on this mountain the Lord will provide.”
