

Flu Season and Suspension of the Cup: The California Department of Public Health has reported that the incidence of flu and flu-like illnesses is widespread and has reached a level requiring measures to prevent the infection at Mass. Bishop Soto has issued the following directives: the use of the Communion cup is suspended temporarily. Receive the Body of Christ in the hand. Avoid shaking hands, offer the sign of Peace with a nod. Do not hold hands during the Our Father. Use alcohol-based antiseptic before and after administering Holy Communion. If you are sick, stay home and take care of yourself. The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and Holy Days does not apply to those who are ill.


