9 Things to Remember This Lenten Season

- 1. Pray Brings us closer to Christ, leaving us changed by the experience we share with Him.
- 2. Fast A form of penance, helping us turn away from sin & towards Christ.
- 3. **Discipline** Set time aside each day to work on your own personal discipline, focusing on the positive.
- 4. **Dying** find aspects of yourself that are less than Christ like and let them die. Christ's suffering & death should be foremost in our minds, join in the mysteries by suffering, dying with Christ & being resurrected in a purified form.
- 5. Humble Stay simple & focused, this is a journey not a race
- **6.** Weakness As our weaknesses are revealed through our journey, recognizing how helpless we are, makes us see God's help with renewed urgency & sincerity.
- 7. **Patience** God is calling us to be patient & see ourselves as He does, with unconditional love.
- **8.** Almsgiving Reach out to others & help as a way of sharing God's unconditional love.
- **9.** Love Giving of ourselves in the midst of suffering & self denial only brings us closer to loving like Christ. As we seek Him out, ask for His help and join in His suffering to learn to love like Him.
