5. **Starting July 3rd, Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers along with the Priest and Deacon will reinstate the Procession to the Altar. Please sit in the chair to the right of the Altar.**
6. **In the absence of a Deacon, the Lector will read the Prayers of the Faithful.**
7. After proclaiming the Second Reading, the Lector will remove the Lectionary and place it below the Ambo.
