**Bishop John Folda is beginning a three-year Eucharistic Revival in the Diocese of Fargo on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, June 19th.** The Solemnity of Corpus Christi, also known as the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, emphasizes the belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, which appears not only in Scripture, but also in letters from early Church Fathers. In around 117 A.D., St. Ignatius of Antioch, near the end of his life, wrote: "I take no delight in corruptible food or in the dainties of this life. What I want is God's bread, which is the flesh of Christ, who came from David's line; and for drink want his blood: an immortal love feast indeed!"
