Corpus Christi Camino, June 22-25.

Join Msgr Goering for a hiking pilgrimage from Dazey, ND to Maryvale, Valley City, for a total of 23 miles with an overnight camping stop at Mel Reiman Campground. This pilgrimage will begin on the feast of Corpus Christi with Mass and procession at St. Mary's in Dazey, ND at 4pm. (A shuttle will be provided from Maryvale.) The Camino is an ancient walking pilgrimage route in Spain, but the word Camino means "the way". The "way" this pilgrimage will take is on the North Country Trail, most of it along Lake Ashtabula. You must bring your own camping equipment, tents, etc. but you will not have to carry it, it will be transported for you. All meals provided. Pilgrims must be 12 years old or older, minors must be accompanied by adults. The cost is \$95 per adult and \$75 per teen, ages 12-17, plus an additional \$15 for the camp site. MIRACLES OF THE EUCHARIST

Eucharistic Miracle of Meerssen Netherlands | 1222-1465 AD

“In 1222 and 1464, two important Eucharistic miracles took place in the town of Meerssen. The first occurred during the Holy Mass, when living Blood dripped from the large Host and stained the corporal. The second occurred in 1456, when a farmer was able to rescue the relic of the miracle from a fire that had destroyed the whole church. The church was later rebuilt, and in 1938 Pope Pius XI raised it to a minor basilica. Numerous pilgrims come every year to Meerssen to venerate the relic of the miracle.”
