Corpus Christi Camino, June 22-25.

MIRACLES OF THE EUCHARIST

Eucharistic Miracle of Rimini Italy | 1227 AD

"This Eucharistic Miracle was performed directly by Saint Anthony after he was challenged by a certain Bonovillo to demonstrate the truth of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The most ancient biography of Saint Anthony, *L'As-sidua* (The Untiring), carries Bonovillo's exact words: "Father! I tell you before all these people: I will believe in the Eucharist if my mule, after fasting for three days, eats the Host which you offer him rather than the fodder which I give him." The mule, despite the fact that it was exhausted by hunger, knelt before the Host and refused its food."
