Invitation to Cursillo—Cursillo is a three-day learning, sharing, inspirational experience of living in a Christian community. It is an encounter with Christ. Groups of men or women meet from Thurs. evening until Sun. afternoon with a team of Spiritual Directors and lay people. The “retreat” portion of the weekend lasts only from opening night until after mass the following morning, during which silence is observed. Thereafter, there are short talks given that emphasize the need for grace, the sacraments, the mass, and prayer to live one's life in union with God. There is also time for informal talk, discussion, singing, joking and laughing, and spontaneous informal prayer.

The atmosphere of Cursillo is one of joy and grace, and it produces wonderful results. Just as Jesus invited the two disciples on the road to Emmaus to “come and see!” He is also inviting you to “come and see” what He wants for you. Eucharistic Miracle of Waldürn Germany | 1330 AD

"...During the Mass a priest accidentally overturned the species of the consecrated wine onto the corporal. [I]t then transformed into Blood and formed an image on the corporal of the Crucified Christ. The relic of the corporal with the Blood is preserved today, placed on the side altar in the minor basilica of Saint George in Waldürn. Every year, several thousand pilgrims visit Waldürn to venerate the sacred relic."
