Year of St. Francis—To mark the 800th Anniversary of St. Francis of Assisi's death, Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed 2026 as a Special Year of St. Francis, inviting the Church to rediscover Francis' witness of peace and charity, his detachment from worldly things, his unity with the Church, and his boldness and zeal for the Gospel. During this year, the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions by making a pilgrimage to a Franciscan church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis.

Exodus 90 (Men's Fraternity at St. Mary's Cathedral)—Exodus 90 is a 90-day spiritual program for men seeking deeper prayer, greater freedom, and authentic fraternity through a structured journey of prayer, discipline, and brotherhood. The program runs **January 5 through Easter 2026**, guided by Scripture and reflections from Fr. Boniface Hicks, OSB, and Jamie Baxter.

Fraternity meetings are Saturdays at ~8:45 am, following 8:00 am Mass. (Mass attendance is highly encouraged.)
