Sacrament of Baptism

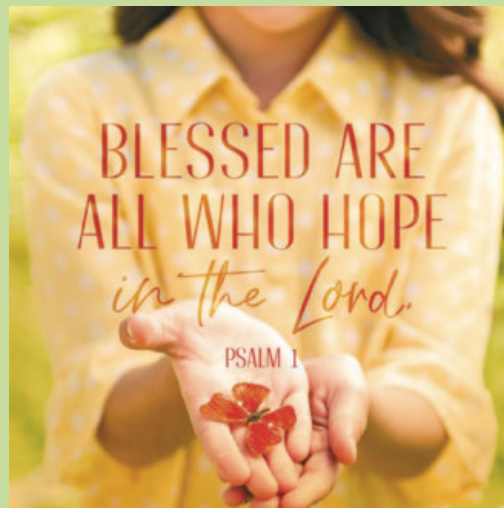

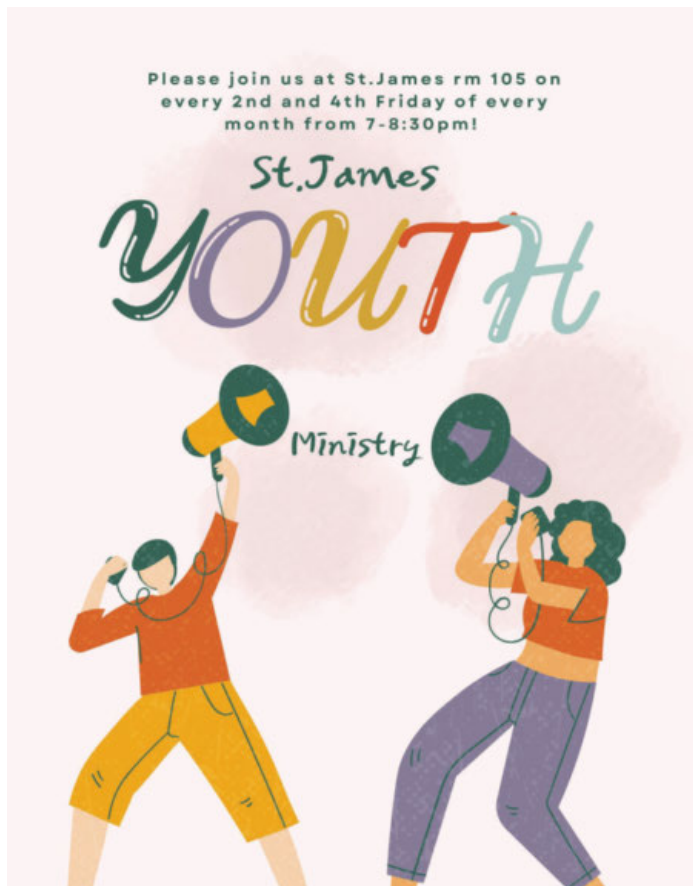

At times life feels out of control and it may feel as though you don't know where to turn. Perhaps, you find yourself as

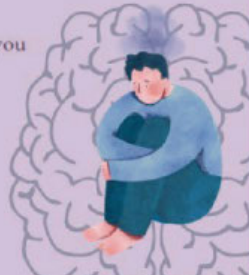
- a caregiver for a family member with mental health challenges

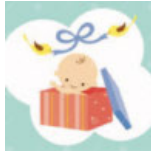

Spiritual Adoption Program

Our Spiritual Adoption Program begins this weekend. Participants in the Spiritual Adoption Program pledge to pray every day for nine months for an unborn baby who is danger of abortion. Since the child is adopted "spiritually", it is not necessary to identify an actual unborn child. However, God knows who the child is. In October, at the end of the nine months of prayer, a baby shower will be held to gather items for A Woman's Concern, a local Pregnancy and Parenting Resource Center that supports mothers and babies. The Spiritual Adoption Program has three goals:

- * Encourage prayer for women who are expecting a child, especially those considering an abortion.
- * Educate adults and children about the development of the pre-born child.
- * Provide mothers in need with a 'baby shower' of baby gifts.

Adoption Cards and Prayer Cards are available at the Spiritual Adoption Marian Shrine in the back of the church. Individuals or families are to complete the Adoption Card and place it on the tree at the Marian Shrine. Monthly updates on the development of the unborn children will be provided in the bulletin and at the Marian Shrine. You are encouraged to stop by the shrine occasionally and say a prayer for good health for the mothers and their babies. Adding the Spiritual Adoption Prayer to your morning prayers, prayer before dinner or prayers at bedtime is a great way to assure saying the prayer daily.
