A Note From Fr. John Lynam

Influenza and the Liturgy

The cold and flu season is upon us again. It is important that we all work together to limit the spread of disease through normal good hygienic practices. It is helpful to recall some things we can do to foster our community's health and well being.

For all members of the congregation:

Keep tissues or a clean handkerchief available for coughs, sneezes, or sniffles. Once a tissue is used, put it in a pocket or purse (perhaps in a simple plastic sandwich bag) until you can properly dispose of it Please do NOT set tissues on the pew seats, NOR in the hymnal racks of the pews.

When a sudden cough or sneeze comes upon you, nestle your mouth and nose in your elbow rather than using your hands. Speaking of hands, be careful of them. Use common sense in keeping them clean and in avoiding contact with mouth or nose in the cold and flu season. You may also want to consider carrying on your person a small container of hand sanitizer.

Note about the Sign of Peace at Mass:

Remember that there is NO single gesture required for the Sign of Peace at Mass. Consider using a gesture that does NOT involve shaking hands. For the Sign of Peace, some offer an embrace, some place a hand on another's shoulder, some simply wave their hand at others without any physical contact. The Sign of Peace at Mass is a time to express our peace in Jesus Christ before we share in the Communion of His Body and Blood. Be thoughtful when you share the Sign of Peace, AND be considerate of the sensitivities of others.

Be mindful and reverent in receiving Holy Communion (as the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion should be in practicing the normal hygienic standards).

Note about Mass attendance when Sick:

If you are very sick or know that you have an easily communicable disease you are NOT bound by the obligation to participate in Mass on the weekend or holy day of obligation. Stay at home and return to the practice of participating in Mass when you are well. Try to watch the Mass on TV or listen to it on the radio. (For longer illnesses, please contact your parish office so that arrangements can be made to have an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion bring the Most Holy Eucharist to you).
