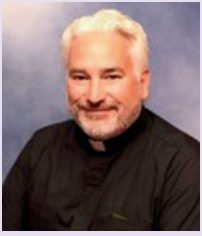

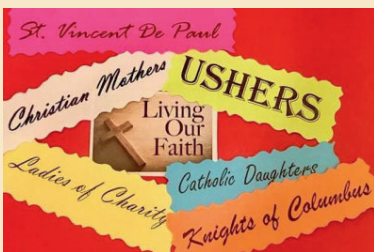

Faith Direct (I.C. Parish)

We are in an unprecedented situation as a community and parish. Some parishioners have inquired about the Faith Direct Program as a way to continue to support church collections. This desire is greatly appreciated, as the financial obligations of the parish continue, even in the midst of this pandemic. Faith Direct is a secure program that works directly with your bank, credit, or debit card in the same way as other electronic funds transfer payments you may already conduct (such as utility bills or your mortgage payment). All transactions are processed electronically, debiting your bank account or charging your credit\debit card automatically for the amounts you designate. You are the only person who can change the amount of money that may be processed on a monthly basis. Participants receive an email each month with the details of your upcoming donations so there will be no surprises. You can stop or adjust your donations at any time. You are not “locked in forever!” If you are interested in learning more or enrolling in this program, visit www.faith.direct/PA633. If you would like an enrollment form mailed to you, or if you have any questions, please call the rectory. Your prayerful consideration is appreciated.

We ask I.C. Parish members who are not currently enrolled in our automatic giving program to now consider signing up for Faith Direct. Faith Direct allows you to make your weekly offertory gift to the church electronically. Among the reasons to sign up for Faith Direct.

- ◇ Parishioners save the cost of checks written to the church
- ◇ Parishioners do not have to worry about missing a collection if they cannot attend Mass because of illness or being out of town.
- ◇ The parish saves the cost of printing and mailing out of envelopes to those parishioners who participate in Faith Direct.
- ◇ Parishioners can also pay their Parish Share pledge through Faith Direct.
- ◇ Participants can track their giving at any time through Faith Direct.
- ◇ The amount given can be changed at any time and a single one time donation can also be made at any time.

We ask any member of IC that is not currently enrolled to please sign up for Faith Direct today. It is cost prohibitive to start a Faith Direct platform for St. Hilary since the merger will take place in less 3 months. ***Once the merger of the parishes occurs in July members of St. Hilary will be able to sign up for Faith Direct.***
