

Mass Intentions

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as a request for healing or on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

We must always remember the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul.

In his encyclical "Ecclesia de Eucharistia," Saint Pope John Paul II, states,

"In the celebration of the Eucharistic Sacrifice, the Church prays that God, the Father of mercies, will grant His children the fullness of the Holy Spirit so that they may become one body and one spirit in Christ. In raising this prayer to the Father of lights, from whom comes every good endowment and every perfect gift, the Church believes that she will be heard, for she prays in union with Christ her Head and Spouse, who takes up this plea of His Bride and joins it to His own redemptive sacrifice. (No. 43)"

In essence, Mass Intentions are powerful. We are required to offer one Sunday Mass for the intentions of the living and deceased parishioners of our parish, but still have many Masses available.



A note from Fr. John Lynam

About a month ago, we were informed by Bishop Zubik that starting July 1, 2020, we would be under the patronage of St. James. However, he did not indicate which St. James (the Greater, the Lesser, the Deacon, the Martyr); there are several. Our look into the history of St. James Parish of 1824 did not yield any fruit either. Therefore, in the

absence of evidence, the presumption is that St. James the Greater must have been the original intention, or the appropriate modifier would have been provided.

As we enter under the protection of St. James, we should know that he was the son of Zebedee and the brother of St. John. He was very close to Jesus and blessed to witness the Glorious Transfiguration of Jesus. St. James was the first Apostle to be martyred (44 AD). His Feast Day is celebrated on July 25 and that will soon become our tradition as well. This year it might be difficult to have a proper celebration with the threat of COVID-19, but perhaps we can offer something on that day. Please see the bulletin in the near future for more details.




