### *A note from our pastor, Fr. John Lynam:*

**From the Diocese:** The decision has been made to open up the churches to 100% occupancy. So when you come to church on Memorial Day weekend (May 29-30) expect to see all the pews open. The mask requirement is still in effect until further notice. We will keep our halls at St. Hilary and Immaculate Conception open for live streaming Mass just in case some might not feel quite safe enough

being in the body of the church.

Other questions like the sign of peace, distribution of Precious Blood and the dispensation for the obligation to attend Sunday Mass have not yet been addressed. As soon as we get information, we will pass it on to you.

Just a word of thanks for all the patience and understanding offered by our parishioners during his time of radical adjustment. May the Lord continue to fill us with the Holy Spirit so that with great docility follow the wherever the Spirit leads us.

The App costs \$4.99 and is available for all iOS and Android users on their smartphones and tablets.



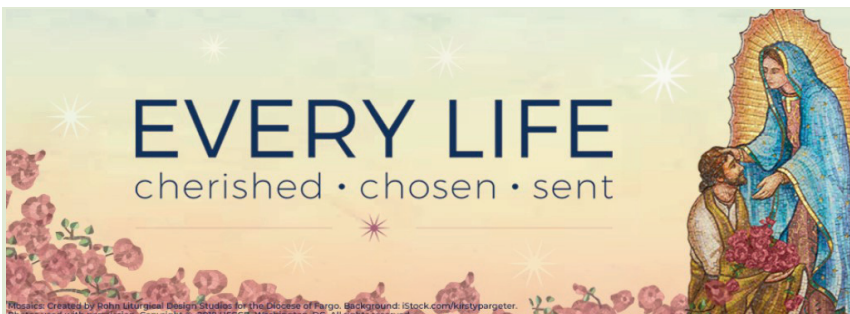
