

Extraordinary Form of the Mass





In today's Gospel we see how Jesus, on his way to Jerusalem, sent a "messenger on ahead of Him." To be the messengers of God, we must know well

what it is God wants to say and do through us, as he sends us out to bring his love to others.

In the month of June, you were the "messenger of God" in bringing hope to the poor. Your gifts enabled the Society of St. Vincent de Paul to assist local families, providing gas cards, as well as money for food, utilities, and rent.


