

From the Desk of Reverend Edward L. Yuhas Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ:

The Gospel from Saint Matthew at Mass this weekend finds Jesus offering us some tall orders: "Offer no resistance to one who is evil...when someone strikes you on your right cheek, turn the other as well...if anyone wants to go to law with you over your tunic, hand over your cloak as well...should anyone press you into service for one mile, go for two miles...give to the one who asks of you, and do not turn your back on one who wants to borrow...love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you."

So many people carry hurt and scars from past relationships until, in their minds, they have settled accounts. Vendettas and grudges, nursing hurts and wounds, sometimes decades old, become the way of life that is even passed down from one generation to the next. The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us: "The teaching of Christ goes so far as to require the forgiveness of offenses. He extends the commandment of love, which is that of the New Law, to all enemies. Liberation in the spirit of the Gospel is incompatible with hatred of one's enemy as a person, but not with hatred of the evil that he does as an enemy" (CCC, 1933).

In our First Reading at Mass this weekend from the Book of Leviticus, the Lord speaks to Moses: "You shall not bear hatred for your brother or sister in your heart...take no revenge and cherish no grudge against any of your people. You shall love your neighbor as yourself...be holy, for I, the Lord, your God, am holy."

The Scriptures given to help us to move toward growth in our spiritual life challenge us to take a thoughtful look into our lives and renew our commitment to try to conform our heart to the generosity of God in all of our relationships, to forgive, not to seek revenge, to work in greater ways for the power of the truth, love and justice, seeking to imitate each day the all-embracing love of God. This is good message for us as we move into the holy season of Lent this week on Ash Wednesday.

"There are three ways of performing an act of mercy:
the merciful word, by forgiving and by comforting;
secondly, if you can offer no word, then pray – that too is mercy;
and thirdly, deeds of mercy.

And when the Last Day comes, we shall be judged from this.

Lenten Regulations

The penitential season of Lent calls all of us to acts of repentance through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Since Lent retains its ancient penitential character, we are to make the entire Lenten season a period of special observance through the three practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. In order to help you explain how this is conveyed through the law that has been handed on to the Church, below you will find an outline of regulations regarding the Lenten season:

- 1. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence in the United States.
- 2. The obligation of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) begins at age 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) obliges all between the ages of 18-59. No one should consider this obligation lightly.
- 3. Those individuals who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful are not obliged to fast, but should perform some other act of penance or charity.
- 4. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors, though not bound by the law of fast and abstinence, are educated in the authentic sense of penance and encouraged to do acts of penance suitable to their age.
- 5. All members of the Christian faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during the Lenten season beyond what is prescribed by the law.
- 6. As a general rule, a request for a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence on Fridays of Lent will not be considered unless some serious reason is present. The attendance at social events, banquets, wedding rehearsals or receptions, or funeral wakes are not considered sufficient reason to request a dispensation.

If you are an active volunteer, registered with the Diocese of Pittsburgh you MUST complete your PGC retraining certification by JUNE 2023. If you do not do so, your records will be "Archived" and you will not be permitted to participate in your ministry until such a time as you have completed all training and all required documents are updated and received in my office.
