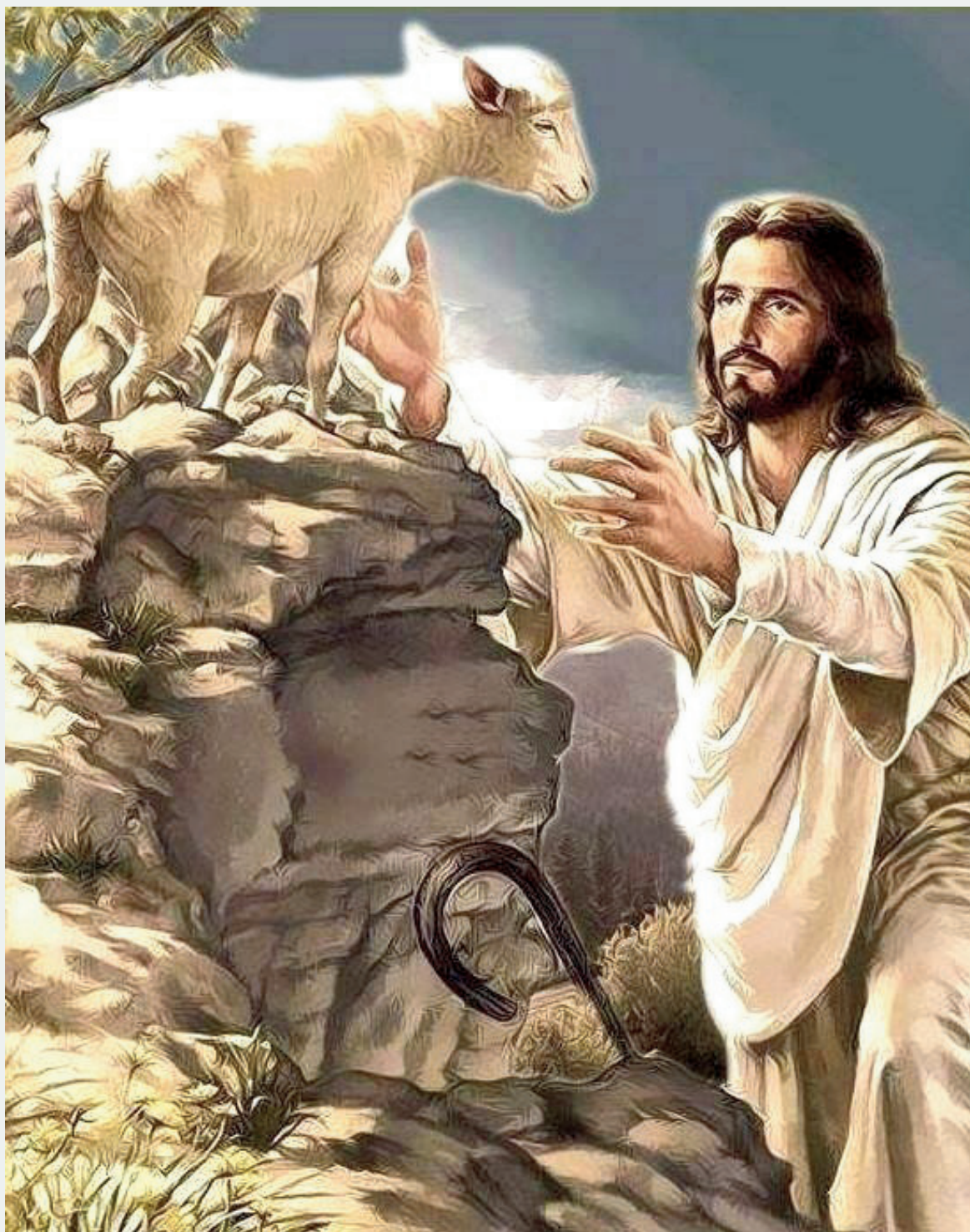

The Fourth Sunday of Easter

From the Desk of Reverend Edward L. Yuhas Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ:

The Church in her liturgy this weekend celebrates what is known as “Good Shepherd Sunday” and the “World Day of Prayer of Vocations.” In our complicated world, we want to know that God will lead us, protect us, and care for us – and he continues to do so through his Church by the Sacrament of Holy Orders, in the ministerial priesthood. It is Christ as priest who gathers, leads, and is present to us in the sacraments. It is the priest who acts in the name and in the person of Christ to gather, lead, teach and guide us closer to God through his Church. All of us share the common responsibility to pray for and support vocations to the priesthood. Let us remember in our prayers our diocesan seminary students.

How blessed both of our parishes are to have seminarians who are discerning God’s call with the Church to serve as future priests. This weekend, Seminarian Alec Scheuer from Saint James Parish is being admitted as a Candidate for Holy Orders at his Pastoral Year Experience assignment at Blessed Trinity Parish (Saint Albert the Great church). The Rite of Admission to Candidacy reminds us: *“For her part, in accepting the seminarian who offers himself [for candidacy], the Church chooses him and calls him so that he may prepare to receive Holy Orders in the future. Since it presupposes a responsible decision on the part of the seminarian, admission among the candidates for Orders is an invitation for him to continue with his formation, in configuring himself to Christ the Shepherd, through a formal recognition on the part of the Church”* (Ratio Fundamentalis Institutionis Sacerdotalis, 2016).

At Saint Katharine Drexel Parish, Seminarian John Kist who was assigned by Bishop Zubik for his Pastoral Year Experience in 2021-2022, is preparing to be ordained to the Sacred Order of the Diaconate on Saturday, June 3, 2023 at 10 AM at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish (Saint Sebastian church).

As we enter into the month of May this week when we honor Mary as Mother of God and Mother of the Church, may we seek her intercession and prayers for our seminarians as we all offer the prayer of the Rosary. Let us be sure that we are praying for Alec Scheurer and John Kist as they journey to serving the Church as priests!

May we provide opportunities in our own homes to pray for, support, and strengthen the awareness of the need for happy and holy vocations to the priesthood, religious life and diaconate.

“There can be no promotion of vocations apart from constant contemplative prayer. The Christian life needs to be nourished by attentive listening to God’s Word and, above all, by the cultivation of a personal relationship with the Lord in Eucharistic adoration, the privileged “place” for our encounter with God.

I wish heartily to encourage this kind of profound friendship with the Lord, above all for the sake of imploring from on high new vocations to the priesthood and the consecrated life. The People of God need to be guided by pastors whose lives are spent in service of the Gospel. May he give us priests enamored of the Gospel, close to all their brothers and sisters, living signs of God’s merciful love.

Mary Most Holy, Mother of our Savior, had the courage to embrace this ideal, placing her youth and her enthusiasm in God’s hands. Through her intercession, may we be granted that same openness of heart, that same readiness to respond: ‘Here I am,’ to the Lord’s call, and that same joy in setting out, like her, to proclaim him to the whole world.”

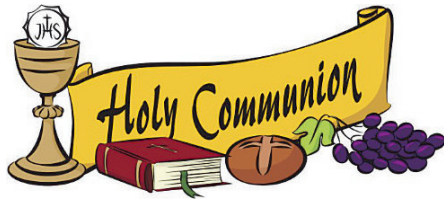

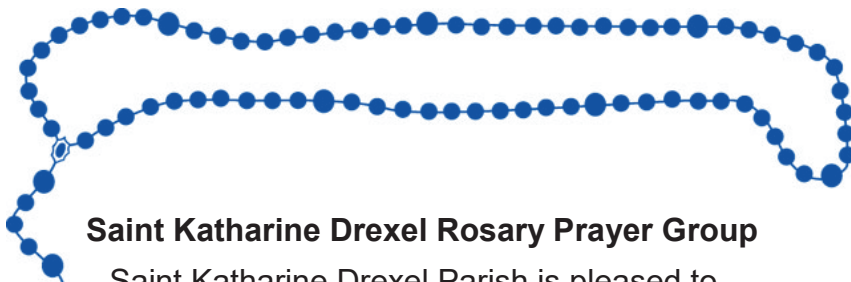

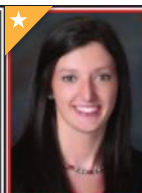
