Dear Friends in Christ:

On the night before Jesus died, he knew that when he left this world, his disciples would continue to be his followers in the Church. He also understood that they and all of us would need help. This is why at the Last Supper, as recorded and proclaimed to us from the Gospel of Saint John this weekend at Mass, Jesus speaks, making the

solemn promise: "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth" (Gospel of Saint John 14:16).

The Holy Spirit is our Advocate, our helper, our guide who is always with us. As the Gospel of Saint John continues, Jesus offers the important message for us to remember that the world neither sees nor accepts the Holy Spirit, but we, equally without seeing, must be open to the movement and power of the Holy Spirit.

In the Second Reading this weekend, Saint Peter says: "Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts. Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks for a reason for your hope" (1Peter 3:16). What Saint Peter reminds us of is for us to give witness to our faith not only by our words but by our actions as well. We are called to be good examples of living the Catholic faith.

May we work to become even greater witnesses of the Good News of the Gospel, not only in what we say, but even more through our actions – living the awesome gift of faith which we share, trusting that the Holy Spirit will be our helper, guiding the way for us to go, the relationships in need of being reconciled and healed.

You may click on the church web site to acquire the current information or telephone the particular church in the area you are visiting.







## **Easter Duty**

During the Easter season – every Catholic is encouraged to make a thorough examination of conscience followed by a good confession in the Sacrament of Penance. This is known as the fulfillment of one's Easter Duty and is rooted in the consistent teaching of the Church as first recorded in the Council of Trent and is reaffirmed in the Catechism of the Catholic Church: "According to the Church's command, 'after having attained the age of discretion, each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year.' Anyone who is aware of having committed a mortal sin must not receive Holy Communion, even if he experiences deep contrition, without having first received sacramental absolution" (CCC, paragraph 1457).

## Novena to the Holy Spirit

### What is a "Novena?"

Novenas are an ancient tradition that goes back to the days of the Apostles. Jesus told His disciples to pray together after His ascension into heaven, so they went to an upper room along with the Blessed Virgin Mary, (Acts 1:14) and joined constantly in prayer for nine days. These nine days of constant prayer by the Apostles at the direction of Jesus led up to Pentecost. This is when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples as "tongues of fire" (Acts 2:1-4). This pattern of 9 days of prayer is the basis the novenas we pray today.

And so, the novena is an imitation of the Lord's command to the Apostles when they prayed for 9 days in anticipation of the coming of the Holy Spirit.

I cling to You and beg You, in Your compassion, to watch over me in my weakness. Holding the pierced feet of Jesus, gazing at His five wounds, trusting to His Precious Blood, and adoring His open side and stricken Heart, I implore You, adorable Spirit, so to keep me in Your grace that I may never sin against You.

Grant me the grace, O Holy Spirit of the Father and the Son, to say to You always and everywhere: "Speak, Lord, for Your servant is listening."

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.
