

This weekend we celebrate the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The liturgical season of Ordinary Time calls us to grow in the Christian virtue of hope and to live out our faith in extraordinary ways - through word and example bringing hope in Christ to all!

### Dear Parishioners of St Katharine Drexel and St. James Partner Parishes.



### The Next Generation Parish

We will be seeing much more of Lucille over the coming years as she is assigned to aid us as a coach through this process of renewal for both our parishes.
