

From the Desk of Reverend Edward L. Yuhas Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ:

In the Gospel we hear at Mass this weekend, Jesus says: "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well. The slaves came to him and said: 'Master, did you not sow good seed in your field, where have the weeds come from?"

The question being put to Jesus was this one: "Why is there evil in the world?" There are many who immediately move into finding fault. Some blame God. They ask: "Why didn't God make a perfect world?" The better question to ask is: "How can we face evil?" Clearly, we live in a less than perfect world. So many people begin efforts with good intentions, with wonderful visions and really want to make life better, both in their own lives and in the lives of others. But, as in so many great efforts, things can go wrong.

As followers of Jesus – what do we do in our lives when we come face to face with evil? That is the exact question raised in the Sacred Scriptures we hear at Mass this weekend. Answering the question is a big problem for all of us. The First Reading from the Book of Wisdom and the Gospel – suggest that we deal with evil as God deals with it – with *patience*, *self-control* and being *steadfast*.

This is a beautiful world that God has created as *good*. What are the struggles that tempt you toward evil? Name them, ask Jesus to help you and pray for patience, self-control and in the face of it all, be steadfast!

Our next "Eat-n-Pray" in the park is THIS Thursday, July 27th at Washington Park – are you coming? Have you invited someone to come with you?



When you arrive at church, please see an usher and explain to them that you are present for the Mass and that you are willing to take up the gifts of bread and wine at the Mass for your loved one and *then be seated in the pew reserved for the gift bearers for each church.* Thank you for your cooperation and we welcome gift bearers at weekend and holy day Masses!

Deacon's Beacon

What is a transitional Deacon?

When I was introduced to the parish I was introduced as a "transitional Deacon". This title is a handy name that is used to clarify that I will soon be ordained to the Priesthood and will not be a Deacon permanently. This title can sometimes be misleading, however, and cause people to believe that there are two types of Diaconate (permanent and transitional). There is only one Diaconate, and it is an ordained office that conforms worthy men to ministry in the Church and to the service of the priesthood and God's people. The permanent deacons at our parish and I share in this same grace of ordination and participation in ministry. I will only be a deacon for one year, however. After the successful completion of this year I will be ordained to the priesthood. Our



"permanent" deacons do not anticipate this second ordination, and out of this distinction the terms "permanent" and "transitional" emerged.

There are a few practical differences that I do want to mention. The first is that while Deacons can be married or unmarried, priests in the Roman Catholic Church remain unmarried. For this reason, "permanent" deacons who are married are not required to take the promise to resolve to live a celibate life, "transitional" deacons do take this promise at their ordination. Secondly, "transitional" deacons wear clerical apparel outside of mass (Roman collar, Cassock, etc.) while "permanent" Deacons in the Diocese of Pittsburgh do not.

All Deacons, however, share in the great and beautiful responsibility to proclaim the Gospel with their words and with their lives!


