
No report this month.

- **Thank You** St Michael the ArchAngel High School reported that St. Robert Bellarmine was the most generous parish in supporting their fundraising efforts for the National Catholic Youth Conference in Indianapolis.
- Care Meals/Meal Train We hadn't been asked to provide meals for a family in years, but received a request from Cynthia Peters daughter, on her parent's behalf. We used an app called Meal Train and everyone has been very generous filling all the spots. The meals have meant so much to Cynthia and Louis. - Give Away The environment committee is doing spring cleaning early. There
 are grapevine wreaths, concrete pillars, and fabric up for grabs. Let us know if

- Nominating Committee We need someone to volunteer to lead the nominating committee to find new candidates for President and Vice President. Volunteer position available.
- Spring Retreat we voted to proceed with planning a Spring retreat. Lent starts
 Feb 14, 2024. We need someone to plan the retreat. Volunteer position
 available.
- Stations of the Cross We will probably be asked again to support one of the stations of the cross by carrying the cross. We will provide more details when they are available.
- Fish Dinner Desserts a healthy discussion occurred when deciding if we should ask people to make desserts or buy them. We purchased desserts last year at a cost of approx. \$200 per dinner and we hosted 3 dinners. Women's Ministry's share of the profits was approx.\$3,000, netting us \$2,400. Pro's to asking for contributions: a) zero cost, b) variety, c) people feel good about contributing. Pro's to buying: a) no need to worry about whether we will have enough b) less work for the women. We tabled the vote until the February meeting.
- **June Meeting** we voted to have the meal catered rather than try to eat at a restaurant. Andrea Kurth volunteered to lead this meeting.
