The Biblical Role of Ushers

Ushers in the Jewish Testament were called door keepers. The Book of Psalms says: "Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked."

In Second Kings chapter 22 the purpose of doorkeepers, (or ushers) was to collect offerings from the people. It says, "Go up to the high priest and have him get ready the money that has been brought into the temple of the Lord." Jeremiah says a doorkeeper (usher) is a person of God. In Ezekiel's vision of the temple, he saw space reserved for priests, musicians, and ushers (Thanks be to God!).

Ushers in the Christian Testament were usually uniform guards who oversaw handling the crowds around the Temple. In the Gospels, Jesus used the disciples as ushers. They directed people who came to hear Jesus speak or be touched by his healing hands. They organized the 5,000 and distributed loaves and fishes to the multitude. Ushers have an incredible role at Mass, putting the congregation in a worshipping spirit. In some churches, parishioners get upset if they do not see their weekly usher, greeting them at one of the doors. It may seem minimal but sometimes a warm smile and a warm greeting can uplift a parishioners' worshipping spirit and even make their day. Ushers make a difference!

Stay tuned as myself and Father Rossi work to reestablish the ministry of ushers here at the parish of St. Anselm. If you have any questions do not hesitate to speak to our priests. God bless you!
