Attendance/Absences and Doctor's Appointments During the School Day:

If your child will not be at school, please call the main school phone and leave a message on the absence line or email. **This should be done by 7:45 AM**. If you are emailing, you MUST send it to the school office at schooloffice @stpeterinchains.org. You may copy the teachers on the email but it is not the teacher's responsibility to forward that information to the office. If you are requesting homework, please mention that on the call or in the email. Please also let us know if you want to pick up a hot lunch or if you want a sibling to eat it. If we know, we can set it aside, but we need to know when you call your child in to school by 7:45 AM.

-State law also requires parents to notify the school in writing upon the student's return to school. This note should indicate the date/s of the absence and the reason for the absence and be submitted to the child's homeroom teacher. If a student has an extended absence of three or more days, a written excuse from the doctor is required. Otherwise, the student's absence may be recorded as unexcused.

- Please try to avoid doctor/dentist/orthodontist appointments during school hours if at all possible as this causes students to miss valuable instructional time. **In order for a tardy or absence to be excused for a doctor's appointment, a doctor's note <u>must</u> be presented after the appointment. Students will be marked unexcused until the doctor's note is received. Please note, unexcused absences can affect student's EdChoice scholarship eligibility and payments.

Dress Code:

As we get into the cooler months, please remember that <u>only</u> approved UNIFORM items can be worn *during* the school day. Dr. Anderson talked to all students today and explained the consequences.

Here is the link to the listing of approved uniform items <u>Shaheen's Uniform Store</u> Please be sure your child is dressed in approved uniform items. If they are cold in class, please see the fleece, sweatshirts, and performance jackets, etc. that are approved to be worn IN the school building. M-TH – these are the items students can wear and the colors of those items that can be worn.

Other jackets, sweatshirts, etc. (Nike, Addidas, Badin sweatshirts, hoodies, winter coats, any non-uniform sweatshirts, etc., etc.) are <u>not</u> to be worn during class and should be removed after a student enters the school building from outside.

Current 8th Graders can wear their class of 2023 hoodie any day.

St. Peter in Chains School spirit wear is only to be worn on Fridays and should not be worn during the school day M-Th. They can be worn TO school but taken off when they get to the classroom.

Please be sure you have reviewed the dress code in the handbook with your children so they are aware of what they cannot wear to school (jewelry, makeup, shoes, etc.). The handbook was signed off on by parents & students at the start of the school year. Violations will result in a conduct point.
