Halloween - Tuesday, October 31

<u>ALL GRADES</u> may wear their Halloween costumes to school (students <u>MUST</u> follow the guidelines below to be able to wear a costume). If a student wishes to not wear a costume, they can wear a Halloween themed outfit (and follow out of uniform guidelines).

Please keep the following in mind when selecting a costume for school:

- Students will be going up and down stairs and participating in gym and recess. We want them to be safe when doing so. Shoes and costumes should not become tripping hazards. **No boots, sandals, Crocs, heels or open toed shoes are permitted**
- Costume masks, weapons, face and hair paint/chalk are not permitted
- Costumes should be tasteful and not scary
- Costumes should allow students easy access to use the restroom (especially if they are in a hurry)

Halloween Parties:

Parties will be on Tuesday, October 31 in the classrooms. We only allow 2 parent volunteers in the classrooms during the parties and they must be Safe Parish certified and have a positive background check on file. No siblings are permitted.

Each room parent will reach out to parents and request items to be sent in if there is a need. Please refrain from sending items to school unless you are asked. Also, please continue to only send in pre-packaged items and no homemade food is permitted. Most importantly, please be mindful of all food or dye allergies that may be present in your child's classroom. We want to keep our students and staff safe.

REGISTRATION - 2024-2025 School Year:

We are trying something different this year. Registration for our CURRENT FAMILIES will begin on November 1, 2023. This will allow us to better plan for the following school year and see how many openings and needs we will have for the following school year.

Registration paperwork for our currently enrolled families will be available on the website beginning November 1 under the Admission tab at www.stpeterhamilton.org

The discounted registration fee of \$50 for one child or \$100 for two or more will run from 11/1 – 11/17/23. *After that date*, the registration fees will be \$75 for one child or \$150 for two or more. Must be paid on Cheddar Up BY 11/17/23 to benefit from the registration fee discount.

All paperwork, fees, updated immunization paperwork and custody papers MUST be turned in to make it a complete registration submission.

In the case of divorce or custody issues, *all* families <u>must</u> submit *current custody* paperwork (even if you are a current family).

Dress Code:

As we get into the cooler months, please remember that <u>only</u> approved UNIFORM items can be worn *during* the school day. Here is the link to the listing of approved uniform items <u>Shaheen's Uniform Store</u> or <u>Schoolbelles</u>. Please be sure your child is dressed in approved uniform items. If they are cold in class, please see the fleece, sweatshirts, and performance jackets, etc. that are approved to be worn IN the school building. M-TH – these are the items students can wear and the colors of those items that can be worn.

Other jackets, sweatshirts, etc. (Nike, Addidas, Badin sweatshirts, hoodies, ANY non-uniform sweatshirts, etc., etc.) are <u>not</u> to be worn during class and should be removed after a student enters the school building from outside.

St. Peter in Chains School spirit wear is only to be worn on Fridays and should not be worn during the school day M-Th. They can be worn TO school but taken off when they get to the classroom.

Mondays – students should wear their Mission Monday t-shirts with IN uniform bottoms. Green school polos can be worn with the current school logo. 8th grade t-shirts should NOT be worn. 8th grade sweatshirts may be worn.

Please be sure you have reviewed the dress code in the handbook with your children so they are aware of what they cannot wear to school (jewelry, makeup, shoes, etc.). The handbook was signed off on by parents & students at the start of the school year. Violations will result in a conduct point.
