REGISTRATION - 2024-2025 School Year - CURRENT families only

If you have not already done so, please register for next school year ASAP to secure your spot for next school year. Please be sure you have completed all steps – 1. Re-enrolled all students on OptionC (see email that was sent out on 11/1/23 2. Paid the registration fee on Cheddar Up.

The registration fees are \$75 for one child or \$150 for two or more. Must be paid on Cheddar Up. Current Family Registration Payment Link

All paperwork, fees, updated immunization paperwork and custody papers MUST be turned in to make it a complete registration submission.

In the case of divorce or custody issues, *all* families <u>must</u> submit *current custody* paperwork (even if you are a current family).



On Tuesday, December 19, 2023, all students from grades K-8 will participate in our mandatory Christmas performance beginning at 7 p.m. in Parrish Auditorium at Miami University - Hamilton.

We will have an all school field trip during the day on Tuesday, December 19th, going by bus, to an off-site venue for practice, lunch, and a dress rehearsal at noon. All students are required to ride the bus to AND from the venue. That day, all students and teachers will need to pack a lunch and a water bottle to consume while at the venue. Permission slips for the rehearsal/field trip day will go home on Thursday, December 7 and are due back to the office by December 14th.

Every <u>school FAMILY</u> will receive <u>THREE</u> tickets for admission to the evening performance that will be sent home with the youngest in the family on Thursday, December 14th. **Should you not require all of the tickets, please turn them back in to the office. The office will have a wait list/sign-up sheet for extra tickets, which will be disbursed on a first come-first served basis. Please be aware there is no guarantee that those on the wait list for extra tickets will receive extra tickets. We will not begin placing names on the wait list until 4PM on December 14. Because of the limited seating for the evening performance, the dress rehearsal at noon will be open to family members who are unable to attend the evening performance **ONLY**. If you are attending the evening performance, PLEASE do not come to the dress rehearsal.

The doors to the evening venue will open at 6:00 PM. No one will be permitted to enter until your ticket is taken by a SPS staff member beginning at 6:00 PM. Every seat is a good seat and has a good view of the stage, so please do not stress to get their super early.

All staff and students will need to report to Parrish Auditorium at 6:30 PM in their designated classroom on the night of the performance. Students should wear nice holiday clothing. Girls – dresses, skirts or slacks; Boys – slacks, dress or polo shirts. Ties/Suits are optional. (Please, no t-shirts, jeans, heels, or sneakers.)

Dress Code:

As we get into the cooler months, please remember that <u>only</u> approved UNIFORM items can be worn *during* the school day. Here is the link to the listing of approved uniform items <u>Shaheen's Uniform Store</u> or <u>Schoolbelles</u>. Please be sure your child is dressed in approved uniform items. If they are cold in class, please see the fleece, sweatshirts, and performance jackets, etc. that are approved to be worn IN the school building. M-TH – these are the items students can wear and the colors of those items that can be worn.

Other jackets, sweatshirts, etc. (Nike, Addidas, Badin sweatshirts, hoodies, ANY non-uniform sweatshirts, etc., etc.) are <u>not</u> to be worn during class and should be removed after a student enters the school building from outside.

St. Peter in Chains School spirit wear is only to be worn on Fridays and should not be worn during the school day M-Th. They can be worn TO school but taken off when they get to the classroom.

Mondays – students should wear their Mission Monday t-shirts with IN uniform bottoms. Green school polos can be worn with the current school logo. 8th grade t-shirts should NOT be worn. 8th grade sweatshirts may be worn.

Please be sure you have reviewed the dress code in the handbook with your children so they are aware of what they cannot wear to school (jewelry, makeup, shoes, etc.). The handbook was signed off on by parents & students at the start of the school year. **Violations will result in a conduct point.**
