## CogAT and IOWA Testing:

<u>MARCH 13-17, 2023</u>: Students in Grades 2, 5 & 7 will participate in CogAT Testing (cognitive abilities testing), which is a series of assessments that estimate a students' learned reasoning and problem solving abilities through a battery of verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal test items.

<u>MARCH 21-27, 2023:</u> ALL students in Grades 1-7 will participate in IOWA Testing, a series of standardized assessments being administered throughout the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Students will be tested for 1-2 hours each morning over the course of a week. *Makeups will be March 28-31.* 

\*\*It is important that all students are present during testing and that appointments are scheduled outside the testing window. Unless it is an emergency, please make an effort to be on time and ready for testing each day.

It is critical to create a test taking environment that's relaxed to allow students to perform their best. IOWA tests will be given at the same time so that the building remains quiet and void of distractions. Teachers will plan stretch breaks and will assign minimal homework.

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Dr. Anderson or your child's homeroom teacher. Your child's homeroom teacher may have already communicated testing information to parents.

#### TIPS TO HELP PREPARE YOUR CHILD FOR A SUCCESSFUL WEEK OF IOWA TESTING:

- Go to bed early each night and get plenty of rest. Turn off games, computers, TV, and cell phones and sleep!
- Eat a healthy breakfast. Even a not so healthy breakfast is better than no breakfast
- Bring a healthy snack for mid-morning
- Be present at school each day and arrive to school on time. Students who arrive late will not be
  permitted to enter classrooms until there is a break in testing. Tardy students will be required
  to make up tests at another time which will take them away from regular class time.
- Finally, encourage your children to say a prayer, relax, and do their best. The rest will fall into place.
- As always, thank you in advance for your support at home.




### Fall 2023 Tackle Football:
