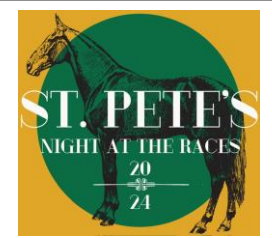

Medical/Dental Appts & Absences:

Just a reminder, medical/dental appointments are discouraged during the school day. We do know that sometimes you have to make that work. Please remember that in order for a tardy or absence to be excused for a doctor's appointment, a doctor's note must be presented after the appointment. If we do not receive the note, the time away will remain as unexcused until the note is presented.

Also, a quick reminder about extended absences – absences of three or more days require a written excuse from the doctor. Otherwise, the student's absence may be recorded as unexcused.

EDCHOICE – 2024-25 School Year:

*****if you have not turned in your EdChoice Renewal Form for next school year, please print off the form using the link below and turn it in with a current utility bill in the office*****

It is now time for current families to fill out and send in the EdChoice renewal applications for the 24/24 school year.

If your family was awarded a scholarship for the current school year (23/24), you need to fill out the renewal form (linked below to be printed) **AND** send a current utility bill that shows the mailing AND service address. **You can send them in with your child to the school office.** Please see the link below that lists acceptable forms of Address Proof. If you live in Hamilton, the Hamilton Utilities bill lists everything that is needed. PO Boxes are not accepted in most cases.

****If your family's application has not been approved yet for the current school year, please contact the school office to find out what items the EdChoice office is waiting on from you. If you do not submit the items they are requesting or have not entered your income paperwork, your application will remain in the Under Review status and then eventually marked as Not Eligible.**
