VOLUNTEERING IN THE SCHOOL OR PARISH:

ANYONE who wishes to volunteer in our school or the parish **MUST** be certified with Safe Parish trainings AND have a positive background check on file thru Selection.com You must also keep up on the trainings throughout the year.

You must also stay up to date on the Safe Parish trainings that are sent out via email. All approved volunteers are checked prior to the time of the event scheduled for to be sure they are up to date on the trainings.

Right now there is a delay with background checks for those that live or have lived in Butler County – this is due to a cyber attack/data breach. Background checks are backed up. Please be patient and know that we cannot change this scenario. **Those who that are not Safe Parish certified AND have a positive background check on file cannot be on campus or around our students (including coaching).** This is an Archdiocesan rule. Our ultimate goal is to keep our kids safe, so please be patient and show some grace.
