A Letter from Fr. Pablo Bonello

Dear Parishioners,

The last chapter of our Encyclical meditates on the mystery of the Eucharist with Mary, through Mary, and in Mary. The mysteries of Christ's life that are especially related to her anticipate *the Church's Eucharistic faith*, St. John Paul II affirms.

The Annunciation recalls the faith of Mary, which in a certain sense is renewed whenever we say Amen at the moment of communion.

The Visitation announces that one day Jesus will continue to sanctify the world hidden under the veils of bread and wine.

At the Nativity, Mary worshiped Her Son with her whole being; she began the worship to the Child now prolonged with the Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament.

Also, the Nativity of the Lord is sort of an announcement of sacramental communion: *is not the enraptured gaze of Mary as she contemplated the face of the newborn Christ and cradled him in her arms that unparalleled model of love which should inspire us every time we receive Eucharistic communion?*

Jesus in Mary's arms, Jesus in our bodies as well. With her faith, love, hope, humility, prayer, and gratitude we receive Jesus. With Mary we worship Him; with Mary we thank Him; with Mary we proclaim the greatness of the Lord and our joy in Him.

We are given this grace whenever we receive Jesus in Holy Communion; especially on Sundays.
